Louisiana Museum of Modern Art

An international museum located outside Copenhagen that strikes the rarest of balances between art, architecture and nature. The art museum is located on the shore of The Sound in Humlebæk



Kronborg Castle - World Heritage Site Kronborg Castle is a historical fixture in the town of Elsinore ('Helsingør'). Immortalized in Shakespeare's Hamlet ... "To be or not to be"



Tivoli Gardens

Tivoli Gardens (or simply Tivoli) is an amusement park and garden in the heart of downtown Copenhagen. Tivoli is the most visited theme park in Scandinavia and the fifth most visited theme park in Europe.



Kopenhagen Fur

Kopenhagen Fur is owned and managed by Danish Fur Breeders Association, a co-operative which was founded in 1930. Kopenhagen Fur produces more than 40 per cent of the world's mink skin.



Bakken - the world's oldest amusement park

Founded in 1583, Bakken, or Dyrehavsbakken as it is officially named, has been a favorite with the people of Copenhagen for centuries. It is worth a visit during the evening to experience the atmosphere.



Nyhavn - 17th century waterfront

Nyhavn (New Harbor) is a 17th-century waterfront, canal and entertainment district in Copenhagen lined by brightly colored 17th and early 18th century townhouses and bars, cafes and restaurants and many historical wooden ships.



Strøget – Europe's longest pedestrian shopping street Strøget is a pedestrian street located at the center of the old city of Copenhagen; it has long been one of the most high-profile streets in the city, famous for its shopping.



Canal Tours - Grand Tour of Copenhagen

Sightseeing by boat is a wonderful way of seeing Copenhagen. During the tour, you will see: The Royal Danish Opera, Amalienborg Royal Palace, Christiansborg Palace, the impressive Black Diamond Library, and, of course, the Little Mermaid.
